Growth Groups

At the beginning of the summer, I talked about the 8 systems of a healthy church. One of those systems is Small Groups. Hosanna has been doing small groups already but we're going to expand on it even more. Before we might have called these groups bible study or Sunday School. Growth groups are more than that; They're about growing in our faith through studying scripture, discussion, fellowship, and service.

In the past we might have offered one group at a time. Now we're going to offer multiple groups at once. This will offer more time choices and a variety of topics so more people can participate.

What are Growth Groups?

- Small groups based around a specific topic.
- Multiple groups are offered at once (more options for topics and times).
- A chance to meet others and GROW in your faith!

When are Growth Groups?

- Short-term (10-12 weeks)
- 60-90 minutes each week.
- Perfect attendance is not required
- Offered 3 semesters throughout the year with one month off in between.

- In the future, we might offer more specific groups for couples, young adults, parents, etc.
- Groups are capped at 15-20 people.
- People may join more than one group if there is room.

Where will Growth Groups meet?

• Different locations (at church or in the Growth Group Leader's home)

What materials do I need?

- Most Growth Groups will use a book.
- There is no cost for the book; donations will be accepted though.
- Or you may find an e-copy of the book or borrow it from the library.

- Grow in your faith.
- Grow closer to Jesus.


The kids will follow along with the Sunday lessons and sermon through stories, coloring and games. This is during both services.

This group will explore the Gospels on Sunday mornings through movies and other pop culture. They will also have fellowship events at other times.




This group will explore Luther's Small Catechism through fun fellowship events, service projects and bible exploration.

Frequently Asked Questions

What is a growth group?

Growth Groups are Hosanna's groups of 15-20 people that meet to learn more about the Bible, growing in their faith, and hang with some great new friends.

Is there a group that's right for me?

There are 5 different groups to choose from this semester that meet at different times and almost every day of the week, so you'll have the chance to find the group that is right for you. And you'll have the opportunity to meet others who share your experiences.

(Let us know if you do not find a group that works for you because of the time it is offered or interest, so we can continue to plan for upcoming semesters.)

How do I sign up?

Sign up either on the Connection Card or in the Narthex/lobby on Sunday Mornings, or online via website.

What happens when I sign up?

When you sign up, the leader of your new Growth Group will contact you and introduce themselves and provide any needed information to have a great experience.

When will my group meet?

Our Growth Groups meet once a week, and each meeting is just 60-90 minutes long. Groups meet 10-12 times over the semester. It's a short-term commitment but the positive impact on your life will be long-term.

How much do the materials cost?

There is no required cost. We accept donations for the books. If you'd like an exact cost of your book, please stop by the Growth Groups Table in the narthex/lobby. You may also purchase your own book or look for a copy at the library.

What will the people in my group be like?

Growth Groups are made up of a variety of people who attend Hosanna. You'll meet some new people as well as reconnect with familiar faces. Growth Groups are a safe and fun way to connect with others and meet some wonderful people.
